- One winner will be selected based on the applications and essays submitted. Selection will be based on scholarship, community service, and financial need.
- The award will be announced at the appropriate high school graduation ceremony

ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS WILL:

- Be a resident of the Mohawk Valley, Oregon
- Have been accepted to a post-secondary institution. Qualifying institutions are two and four year colleges and universities, community colleges, and technical and trade schools.
- Be a full time student
- Submit a completed application package, including the application form, letters of reference, high school transcripts, FAFSA, and essay of not fewer than 500 words as outlined below.
- Submit the completed package to no later than **May 15, 2014**

REFERENCE LETTERS:

Include a minimum of 2 letters of reference, at least one of which must be from a high school staff member. The second, and any additional letters may be from a person of your choice.

CULMINATING ESSAY:

Submit a typed essay of between 500 and 1,000 words including your answers to the following questions:

- What service work have you done and how has that work been of benefit to you and to the community?
- How do you hope that your college education will make you a better person?
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- How do you plan to use your college education?
